ARCHITECTURE DESIGN STUDIO WITH AN ADDITIONAL DESIGN RELATED FOCUS AREA

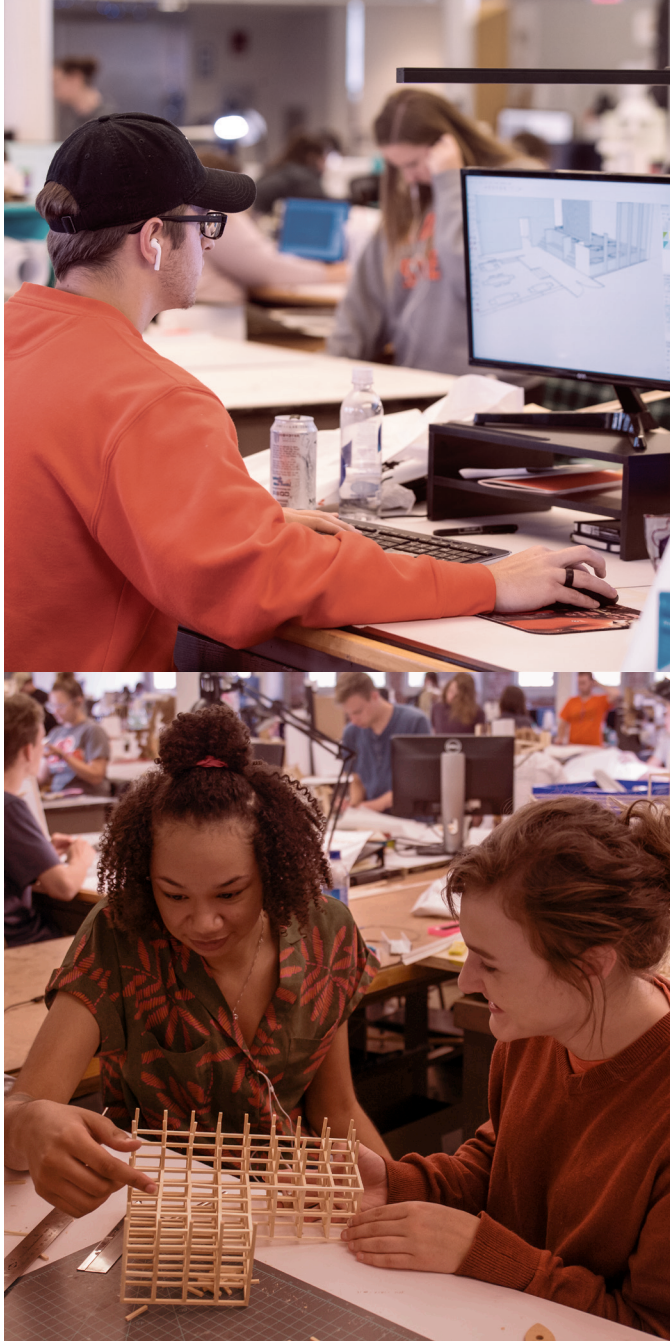
Oklahoma State University School of Architecture is accepting applications for one tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Architecture. The successful candidate is expected to instruct design studio courses as well as have a second emphasis in a topic closely related to architecture. The position is primarily focused upon teaching, however all faculty are expected to develop a creative and scholarly agenda that contributes to the mission and goals of the school, college, and university.

About the OSU School of Architecture

Candidate Credentials

Candidates are required to have a professional degree in architecture. Additionally, applicants must hold a terminal degree in architecture or a related field. Preference will be given to candidates who have a professional license.

Successful candidates must be versatile studio instructors and capable of teaching at the foundations and advanced level design studios. They are also expected to have a clear research agenda and offer courses that contribute to the School of Architecture academic curriculum.
