New CIVE funds this fiscal year, Fiscal Year 2023 (July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023)


New scholarship fund - 26-01290 Mike and Nancy Tate Endowed Graduate Fellowship

The Civil and Environmental Engineering Fund (26-66000) is probably our single most important fund. This is the general purpose fund that we can use to support all of our departmental initiatives. This fund supports:

- · Recognition of our graduates, which traditionally includes the Senior Dinner and the Cowboy Hard Hats and safety vests
- Support to student clubs and organizations
- The Engineering North renovation project, as well as furniture and other enhancements for the new spaces
- Study Abroad travel scholarships
- Supporting our efforts to recruit high quality faculty for the program.

Therefore, I would like to ask you to help us out with that fund. Through summer 2019, the school has awarded over 3,000 BSCE degrees. If half of our graduates gave just \$50 every year, that would provide \$75,000 to support these efforts. Opportunities remain to support the Engineering North 2nd Floor Renovation Project. The figure below shows the spaces that have been named in gray. There are several faculty offices and other spaces that you can sponsor.
