Most recently Tim was awarded lifetime career achievement recognition as a Fellow of the ASSP. Page-Bottorff is a safety trainer, author, podcast host and highly sought after motivational keynote speaker. He lectures for the OSHA Education Center at the University of California San Diego Extension and at the University of Maryland Global Campus in addition to numerous professional development conferences across the country.
