Mechatronics and robotics major developing immersive language-learning technology

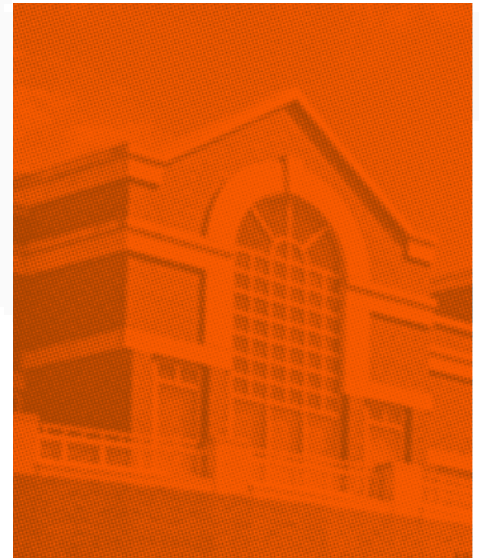
