## Two CEAT alumni honored with OSU's highest awards for impact and achievement

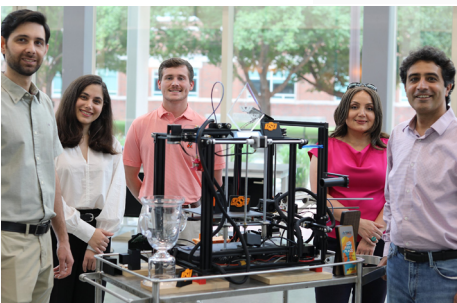
