CEAT alumnus Lamkin recognized for contributions to STEM community

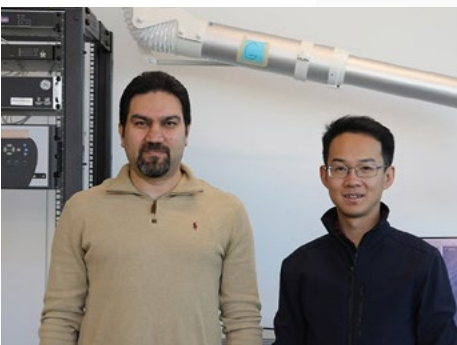

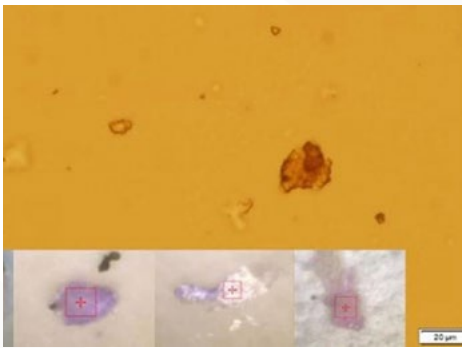
Radonjic elected to serve on the National Academies Organizing Committee for the Orphan Wells Workshop
