


Sky Rogers is the Assistant Director of OSU's Center for Sovereign Nations and the Co-Advisor of the OSU Native American Student Association.

Anthony Blatt, AIA

Anthony Blatt (Tony), a 1993 graduate from Oklahoma State with a BA in Architecture, has witnessed the transformation of Oklahoma City these past 30 years. Tony worked for HTB and Benham before joining with David Hornbeek where was a principal for Hornbeek Blatt Architects for over 20 years. In 2021, Tony acquired ownership and in 2022 merged with the Oklahoma City based architecture firm ADG to form ADG Blatt where he is now Chief of Operations and Architecture

Tony has worked on a wide range of projects during his career, including corporate, government, educational, healthcare, recreational, hospitality and cultural museums. One notable project is the First Americans Museum with Hornbeek Blatt and Johnson Fain of Los Angeles as co-prime architects. Tony personally worked on this iconic project for 24 years from drawings through all construction phases and is currently working on the last gallery installation.

Tony has been both a committee member and chairperson of the OKC Riverfront Design Review Committee and is currently serving on the Oklahoma City Urban Design Commission, the OKC Downtown Design Review Committee, the OSU School of Architecture Professional Advisory Council and is the chairperson for the OKC Foundation for Architecture. Additional noteworthy projects in Tony's portfolio include the OKC 21C Museum Hotel, Oklahoma City Community Foundation, Variety Care medical clinics, MAPS3 Senior Wellness Center No. 3, Edmond Center Court, and UCO Chad Richison Stadium expansion.

Tony and his wife, Julie, are long-time residents of Edmond, where they have raised three children, all students or alums of OSU College of Engineering, Architecture and Technology.

For nearly 25 years, Gena has committed her professional career to the pursuit of planning and guiding cultural projects in Indian Country toward successful completion. She championed the dream to build an American Indian Cultural Center and Museum in Oklahoma. As Director of the Native American Cultural & Educational Authority, Gena led the development of a nearly 300-acre site on the Oklahoma River envisioned to be the future home of a world-class cultural destination, a landscaped and programmed park and trails system, commercial development and visitor welcome center. In 1996, Gena graduated from Oklahoma State University. She received the Outstanding Contribution to the Native American Community award. In 1999, she graduated from the University of Oklahoma College of Law. Over the years, Gena has provided a multitude of local, statewide, national and international public keynote speeches, presentations and lectures on project development and management, as well as Oklahoma tribal cultures, cultural tourism, and economic development in Indian Country. In 2013, Gena formed Luksi Group, LLC, a consulting business that provides cultural direction for creative design in Indian Country projects. Gena was recently engaged with the Choctaw Nation in the planning of the Choctaw Cultural Center, and as a consultant on the completion of the First Americans Museum. She is an attorney and continues her work today in project management, mediation practice, and tribal consultation.
