## **Networking Letter Format**

Use the heading from your resume for your contact information

Dear Mr. Rich:

Use this type of letter when you and the employer share a respected mutual contact. This can serve for both informational interviews and job applications. See Ready Reference F-4 and F-5 for other types of sample cover letters.
