Academic Opportunities: Global Studies Japan offers 3 credit hours (ENGR 4063 (I)) with lecture topics taught by OSU Faculty, including field trips to cultural sites and industry leaders. Students will have an opportunity to spend time with Japanese engineers and technical executives during industry visits.

Through readings, cultural site visits and walking tours, students will come to understand the complex nature of cultural diversity. Students will be responsible for a written report as well as journaling/blogging to document their course experience. (required)

Eligibility: Open to all students enrolled at OSU. Maximum program size is limited to 20 students. Minimum 2.25GPA required. This course may count as a technical elective course toward your degree. Please check with your advisor to determine if credits will count toward degree requirements.

Dates: May 10—22, 2022

Airfare: Group airfare may be available if enough students are interested or students may purchase airfare directly. Please do **NOT** purchase airfare until a class information session is held. Group will be required to meet at set point and time in Tokyo to finalize rail card and other internal travel issues.

Financial Aid : CEAT Study Abroad Scholarship and OSU Provost Scholarship.

Deadlines are: CEAT Study Abroad is January 25, 2022 and OSU Provost is December 1, 2021 for the early bird and February 15, 2022 for the final deadline. If you are eligible for FAFSA, you may use your FAFSA benefits in the summer semester **IF** you take at least 6 credit hours. Please see the CEAT Study Abroad web site for more scholarship information under Continuing Student Scholarships: Study Abroad Program cost: \$3200 will include: 3 credit hours of tuition, housing, some meals, local transportation (a rail card will be purchased for each student) and in-country field trips, international traveler's insurance to include health insurance during travel dates.

Miscellaneous: Program cost does not include international round trip airfare, personal spending money, meals not included in above program cost and if needed, passports, VISA or immunizations. Flights are estimated at \$1200 round trip.

Application procedures: Register at <https://global.okstate.edu/studyabroad/> is required as well as enrolling in Banner for summer course. You must be registered through the OSU Study Abroad Office to receive a Provost Scholarship.
