Cultural Opportunities: Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City tours, a tour of local markets, a cooking class, night scooter food tour, and a side trip to Halong Bay. For a day-long cruise Students will have the opportunity to visit the Biosphere, a rebuilt and sustainable area near Ho Chi Minh City, the Mekong Delta, Tu Chi Tunnels and to work with Ho Chi Minh City University students and visits to various engineering firms and fetes.

Academic Opportunities: Global Studies Vietnam offers 3 credit hours (ENGR 4063 (I)) with lecture topics taught by OSU Faculty, including field trips to cultural sites and industry leaders. Through readings, cultural site visits and walking tours, students will come to understand the complex nature of cultural diversity and how Engineering solutions can be altered based on the local area resources. Students will be responsible for a written report as well as journaling/blogging to document their course experience. (Required)

Eligibility: Open to all students enrolled at OSU. Maximum program size is limited to 20 students. Minimum 2.25GPA required. Please check with your advisor to determine if credits will count toward degree requirements. An (I) has been requested for the (I) General Education degree requirement.

Dates: March 11—20, 2022

Airfare: Student is responsible for purchasing their own tickets.

Financial Aid : CEAT Study Abroad Scholarship and OSU Provost Scholarship. Deadlines are: CEAT Study Abroad Scholarship- January 25, 2022 and OSU Provost is December 1, 2021 for winter break and spring break scholarship deadlines. If you are eligible for FAFSA, you may use your FAFSA benefits. You should check with OSU Financial Aid office for more information concerning FAFSA and study abroad funding.

Program cost: Approximately \$2200 and will include: 3 credit hours of tuition, housing, some meals, local transportation and in-country field trips, basic international traveler's insurance to include health insurance during travel dates. You may purchase more travel insurance if you feel you need to do so.

Miscellaneous: Program cost does not include international round trip airfare (approximately \$1200), personal spending money, meals not included in above program cost and if needed, passports, VISA or immunizations.

Application procedures: Register NOW at abroad.okstate.edu is required . You will ALSO need to enroll in Banner! in January 2022. **You must be registered for a study abroad program through abroad.okstate.edu to receive a Provost Scholarship.**
