Mitch Myers received his BS in Industrial Engineering and Management (IEM) from Oklahoma State University in 1995 and his Master’s in Business Administration (MBA) in 1999 from OSU.

Early in his career, he served for 13 years as Vice President of Operations for FW Murphy where he was responsible for global operations. His functional responsibilities included manufacturing, supply chain management, materials management, customer service, quality assurance and information technology.

In 2007, Mr. Myers began the process of acquiring a manufacturing and industrial services company, Thermal Specialties, LLC headquartered in Tulsa. Since then, he has become a serial entrepreneur. He has started or acquired several new companies in a diverse set of industries and applications – a total of nine operating companies across real estate, manufacturing, medical benefits, construction, interior design, and commercial trades.

In addition to Mr. Myers’ entrepreneurial pursuits, he is passionate about the importance of education and serving OSU in an Alumni leadership capacity for over 20 years.
